



Account of Purley on Thames

Chronicles 1500-1519

1500 - 15/16 Hy VII

Margaret Twynhoo, daughter of the late Nicholas Carewe, died a widow and left 6/8 to the Parish Church of Purley in her will. In return the church was requested to set her name and those of her parents and husbands in the Bederoll and thus regularly remembered in prayers. She also left instructions that she was to be buried in Greyfriars Church in Reading ' as naye the toumbe which I have made over my fader and moder as can conveniently be ' (ref 61-1500-1; 136-1899-p49)

Richard Davy became Vicar of Purley after the previous incumbent had died (ref 115)

Christopher Twynhoo became Provost of the College of St Edmund Salisbury and thus Patron of Purley Church. It is possible he was the brother in law or nephew of Margaret, daughter of Nicholas Carew who died in 1500.

1507 - 22/23 Hy VII

Sir William Norreys died and was succeeded as Lord of the Manor of Purley Parva by his eldest son Richard (ref 24-79)

1510 - 1/2 Hy VIII

1511 - 2/3 Hy VIII

1512 - 3/4 Hy VIII

Sir John St John died and his wife Joan (nee Iwardby) settled the the reversion of the manor of Purley Magna on Elizabeth one of the daughters of Richard Blount of Mapledurham and her and John's son Nicholas who later married Elizabeth and came to live in Purley. The estate seems to have been part of Joan's dowry but when her husband died it reverted back to the Iwardby family and Sanchia, Joan's mother became Lord of the Manor. Sanchia Iwardby had been succeeded as Lord of the Manor of Purley Magna by her daughter Joan,

then the wife of Nicholas Saunder. Joan had previously been married to Sir John St John of Lydiard Tregose in Wiltshire (ref 26-iii-419)
