

Appendix 2 - Curates

The style 'curate' has had several slightly different meanings over the years and one or other of the people listed below fall into all these meanings:. Technically the term means the person who has the cure of souls in the parish and should apply to the incumbent.

A person paid by the rector to fulfil his duties while he is absent from the Parish, usually because he was a pluralist.

A person who assisted the rector either on a full or part time basis.

A person who ministered in the Parish during an inter-regnum.

A person who conducted an occasional service in the church. (As far as possible this latter group have been omitted from the list)

A non-stipendary minister
